Since the Islamic regime of Iran took power in 1979, people in Iran have been deprived from their basic rights including their freedom of expression. Soon after the regime established its power, mass arrestment, imprisonment and execution of dissident started. Since 1979, no opposition has been tolerated, and slightest resistance to the establishment has been faced with fiercest punishment. This has been the living situation in Iran for more than 30 years, and since then, the number of political prisoners have been on the rise.

Summer of 2009 brought thousands to the street, demonstration following the so called election of Ahmadinejad grew larger and larger. Following that thousands of demonstrators, including young boys and girls, have been arrested, tortured and even raped. Many of these boys and girls, who are even as young as 12 years old, have been raped and brutally tortured by the “revolutionary guards”. As you read these lines, many of them are still in prison and awaiting their death sentences.

People have been protesting against the viciousness of the regime and have been fighting to gain their right for freedom of expression. They came to the street demanding change, not just the change from one politician to another, rather they wanted to change from tyranny to a free society, but what they have got instead is imprisonment, torture and execution. People in Iran have been demonstrating to demand the release of all political prisoners; families of the prisoners have been gathering in front of prisons,

including the notorious Evin Prison, demanding the release of their sons and daughters; these families have been attacked and arrested by the Islamic regime constantly.

Political prisoners in Iran need your support. Their voice needs to be echoed all around the world. You can make a difference by demanding the release of all political prisoners in Iran. An international support is the key to success.

Eyewitness reports from different prisons in Iran

“Imprisoned girls were taped until their uteruses were torn apart, while young boys were sexually abused so savagely that they are suffering from serious depression as well as physical and mental traumas”

“I saw a person who had all but his two upper teeth knocked out, his nails had been pulled out, his head had been bashed and I knew that his kidney had stopped functioning. But what most disturbed me was the signs of rape on the body, stitches around very sensitive part of his body; he had been brutally raped.”

“Raping and sexually assaulting prisoners using batons, taking their clothes off, pouring water on them and lashing them while their body is wet so the prisoners feel more pain in the very hot days of summer, guards would force prisoners to crawl on the ground on hot asphalt and then they walk on prisoners’ hands and feet while they are crawling and break the bones in their hands and feet.”
